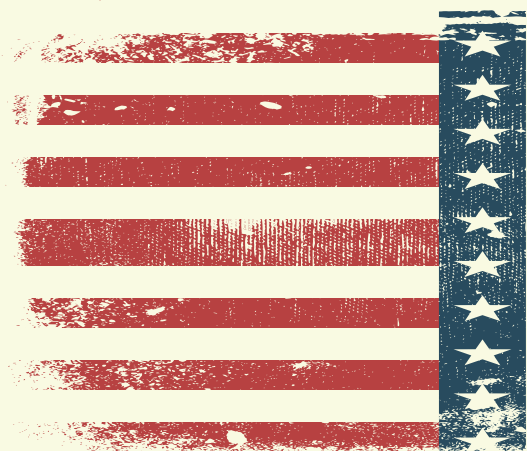

MAY IS MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH

Kansas law requires that under 18 years of age wear a DOT-approved helmet while riding. Eye protection is also required unless you have 10 inch high windshield.

- NHTSA estimates that helmets saved 1,872 motorcyclists' lives in 2017, and that 749 more lives could have been saved if all motorcyclists had worn helmets.
- In States without universal helmet laws, 57 percent of motorcyclists killed in 2017 were not wearing helmets, as compared to 8 percent in States with universal helmet laws.

The Idaho House of Representatives passed senate bill 1292 the profiling bill. Idaho is the fourth state in the nation to pass a profiling bill into law.

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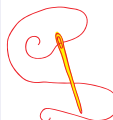
